Happy October! It is the start of the season of pumpkins, colorful leaves and football! In Fairfax County schools, it is also the time when we develop our school improvement plan and it is submitted to our Cluster VI Assistant Superintendent. This year will continue to make reading and math the focus of our academic goal. Helping students understand personal goal setting and service learning continue to be our focus for the second part of the school improvement plan.

This school year has brought several new things for us to work with – a new elementary school progress report, a new online math text-

book, a new teacher evaluation process and Falcon Time. All Fairfax County schools have a time that is used to work with students to extend the curriculum or reteach skills that were not fully understood. Falcon Time is from 1-1:30, Tuesday-Friday. During this time, teachers work with students in small groups and/or individually to ensure students have learned concepts recently taught to prevent learning gaps. This time is also used to extend the curriculum for students who have already mastered the skills and concepts taught.

This time of year also brings our annual parent conference days – Nov. 5-6. These are student holidays that provide time for our teachers to meet with parents to discuss individual student progress.

In traditional Sangster fashion, we look forward to meeting with all parents. Being a former social studies teacher, I hope that everyone will take time to vote on Nov. 6 as well.

I will not be at Sangster during those days, as I will be heading to China for two weeks. I am honored to have been selected to serve on a delegation of educators to visit several provinces in China and work with Chinese educators. An acting principal will be in place while I am gone. As soon as that individual has been named by our cluster VI Assistant Superintendent, I will let the community know.

I hope everyone enjoys the beginning of the crisp fall weather.

- Have your order shipped directly to you. Shipping is free for orders over \$50 and just \$3.95 for orders less than \$50.


Sangster receives 40% of the proceeds from every order that uses our code. So please encourage friends, family and colleagues to shop Sally Foster and help us earn dollars for our school.




Click on the meeting entry to see the page below.
