Chess club is taught by experienced Silver Knights instructors using a curriculum developed by National Masters. Each weekly session is a mix of learning and play. Playing chess is a great way to develop a child's critical thinking skills, sportsmanship, and patience — all while having fun!

- ⇒ Dates: Club meets every Friday that school is in session, starting on 10/6 and ending on 1/12.

In **Tournament Training**, every week students play a game against a player close to their skill level. The game is then analyzed in a group setting with a highly-rated chess coach and peers. It's a great next step for students who really love chess club!

Beginning tournament players learn how to take chess notation, play with a clock, and the value of game analysis. Intermediate and advanced players get serious games against tough opposition and analysis from master-level coaches.

- ⇒ All grades welcome. Students must be able to intentionally checkmate an opponent to be eligible.
- ⇒ Dates: Club meets every Thursday that school is in session, starting on 10/5 and ending on 1/4.
- ⇒ Time: 7:30– 8:50 AM
- ⇒ All equipment provided.
- ⇒ Club meets in POD A.
- ⇒ Club does not meet on 11/23, 12/21, and 12/28. Make-up on 1/11, if needed.
