Dianna Flett is a retired Army Lieutenant Colonel, having served for 21 years in various positions as a military intelligence officer. She is a graduate of Rutgers University and has attended various leadership schools, including the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. Dianna is a combat veteran of Desert Shield/Desert Storm and been awarded the Legion of Merit and the Bronze Star. Dianna is a graduate of the FBI's Instructor Development Course, and worked with the FBI teaching leadership and management strategies to Supervisory Intelligence Agents around the U.S. In 2012, she created Girl Smarts[®] to empower girls before they hit their teen years. In 2013 and 2014, Girl Smarts[®] was featured at the National Conferences on Girl Bullying and Relational Aggression, and, in 2015, Dianna was invited to the first-ever White House Summit on the “United State of Women.”
